Vendor agreement

- This agreement is for food vendors. Independent food operators will be limited and acceptance for all vendors will be at the discretion of the Juneteenth Festival Committee.
- You will be able to serve 1 (one) main course dinner for this fee. The festival must approve each dish. You can offer more than 1 side order. Please include all sides with menu.
- You may only sale items that are on your detailed list. If you want to sell something different, you must get authorization from the Juneteenth Festival Committee. NO EXCEPTIONS. No more than 2 vendors will serve same main course.
- No beverages are to be sold by vendors. You will be asked to leave for this violation
- This Agreement is for space only. The Juneteenth Festival Committee will not supply extension cords, tables or other equipment. The Juneteenth Festival Committee will not be responsible for man power needed to place trailers and equipment. We will only provide electricity.
- Cancellations: or No-Shows. * In the event of an emergency, the Juneteenth Festival Committee will take each situation into consideration and bring it to a vote prior to any refunds.
- Placement for vendors is at the discretion of the Juneteenth Festival Committee. Each application will be reviewed before space assignment is made. Once a space has been designated, vendor cannot move without permission of Committee.

HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

- The Juneteenth Festival Committee will not be responsible for any equipment left on the festival grounds over night, or for lost, stolen or damaged items, equipment, nor personal accidents or injuries, etc _____initial
- All booths, equipment and supplies MUST be removed after closing on Sunday Afternoon by 8:30pm.
- Sharing, trading or selling a contracted booth space is strictly forbidden without written approval from the Juneteenth Festival Committee.
- Selling items not on detailed list is in direct violation of this agreement
Ice will be sold.

ALL FOOD PRICES MUST BE POSTED IN PLAIN VIEW!
You only sell the foods listed on the agreement.

It is the responsibility of each contracted vendor to clean up around the contracted booth area on a continual basis throughout the duration of the Festival. Full trash bags must be placed at trash pickup area.

Setup times will be as follows: Starting Friday 9:00 am. Juneteenth Festival Committee reserves the right to measure after setup; all vehicles must be removed from festival grounds.

Payment in full, signed vendor agreement and initialed hold harmless agreement must accompany this application. Make fees payable; and mail application back to:
